NOTES

THEME 1: Nothing existed with God in the beginning; He alone is eternal and greater than all.



Read Gen. 1:1-2/ Ps. 90:2 and Col. 1:16

*** Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.**

1. How do these verses reveal God as eternal and greater than all?
2. How does mankind and the spirits stack up against the eternal God?
3. How should we respond to the One True God who alone is eternal and uncreated?

THEME 2: God alone is all-powerful and exists by His own power; needing nothing and no one!



Read Gen. 1:1 and Gen. 17:1

*** Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.**

4. How did God survive before there was anything?
5. How is God's existence different than mankind's?
6. What's wrong with the idea that God exists for us?

THEME 3: God is Spirit, ever present, all-seeing, all the time.



Read Heb. 4:13/ Jn. 4:24 and Jer. 23:23-24

*** Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.**

7. How do these verses declare God as Spirit, ever present, and all-seeing?
8. How is mankind's existence different than God's?
9. How should our lives reflect that God is Spirit, ever present, all-seeing, all the time?

THEME 4: God is one, yet trinity -God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.



Read Gen. 1:1-2

*** Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.**

10. How many Gods are referred to in verses one and two?
11. Who is greater amongst God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit?
12. What contrary beliefs to the trinity are we needing to destroy?
13. **What surprised you in God's Word today? Answer then tell someone else?**
