THEME 1: God is always loving and gracious.



Read Gen. 1:27, 31 and Gen. 2:18-20

*** Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.**

1. How was God's grace to Adam unmerited, originated solely within God and had no strings attached to it?
2. How do you think Adam would feel receiving this free gift?
3. What do these verses say about the value and purpose of women?

THEME 2: God desires to be the sole provider for all we need.



Read Gen. 2:21-25

*** Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.**

4. How do these verses reveal God as sole provider?
5. In receiving Eve, how did Adam show what he thought of God as his provider?
6. What does it mean for us today to allow God to be our sole provider?

THEME 3: God alone decided to make mankind in His image for the purpose of a dependent relationship.



Read Gen. 1:27-28 and Rom. 11:36

*** Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.**

7. What was all involved for Adam, being made in the image of God?
8. What was bound up in God's command to Adam and Eve that they were to rule over the earth?
9. God decided to make each of us in His image for the purpose of a dependent relationship. Why is this positive?

THEME 4: God is supreme, holy, powerful and faithful, and thus everything was absolutely perfect .



Read Gen. 1:31, Gen. 2:1-6 and Heb. 10:31

*** Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.**

10. Why does God call everything 'very good' at the end of creation, but during creation, He called it 'good'?
11. Just how wonderful and perfect had God made everything, including mankind?
12. How serious is it for those who dishonour God?
