REVIEW

THEME 1: God openly reveals Himself in providing His one means of rescue for all sinners -repent and believe!



Read Gen. 6:14-16 and Heb. 11:7

* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 1a. How does God openly reveal Himself to Noah to provide for His one means of rescue for all sinners?
- 1b. How did God make the way open to all sinners in Noah's day to escape death in the flood?
- 1c. How is Noah's ark a picture of the coming Deliverer?

THEME 2: All sin must be dealt with as it rejects God and His Word.



Read Gen. 7:11-21

* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 2a. What does God wish to tell us by Him closing the door of the ark before the flood?
- 2b. What characteristics of God do we see in His punishing and rescuing at the flood?
- 2c. What does God say to those who delay in repenting, or say they don't need to because they're good, etc.?

THEME 3: God is good and always does as He says, - nothing can hinder Him!



Read Gen. 8:1-4, 15-21 and Gen. 9:8-13

* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 3a. How was God good to Noah and his family during the flood?
- 3b. How is God good and faithful in His promise about the rainbow?
- 3c. How should we respond to the truth that God is good and always does as He says and nothing can hinder Him ?
