THEME 1: God initiates an unconditional, one-way covenant with someone who doesn't deserve it, so as to bless.
Read Gen. 12:1-3/ Ps. 105:8 and Is. 46:9-11 * Read the verses a few times and answer the questions. 1a. How does God initiate an unconditional covenant with Abram in order to bless?
1b. How does God define a covenant as seen from the covenants that He made?
1c. How did God mean that all families on earth would be blessed through Abram?
THEME 2: God in His love honours the free choice of mankind!
Read Gen. 12:4-5 and Jos. 24:2 * Read the verses a few times and answer the questions. 2a. How did Abram, Sarai and Lot exercise their free will in obeying God?
2b. What were the pros and cons for their decision to obey God?
2c. How are each of us like Abram, Sarai and Lot at birth?
THEME 3: God graciously gives mankind the choice to accept or reject Him, but they bear the consequences for it!
Read Gen. 13:1-18, and Gen. 19:1-29 * Read the verses a few times and answer the questions. 3a. What were the consequences for Abram, Lot and Sodom's choices?
3b. Why would the angels say, "the outcry against Sodom has become great BEFORE THE LORD?
3c. Why couldn't God destroy Sodom with Lot living there and what does that mean for us today?
