

LESSON 21 –MOSES, EGYPT AND THE PLAGUES

NOTES

THEME 1: Sinners are helplessly enslaved to sin and Satan, who seek to destroy them. But God provides a Deliverer.



Read Ex. 1:8-11/ Ex. 2:1-6 and Ex. 3:1-10

* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 1a. How do these verses reveal that sinners are helplessly enslaved to sin and Satan, but provides a deliverer?
- 1b. What lengths did God go to in order to fulfill His plan of rescue for the Israelites?
- 1c. How is our situation similar to Israel's while in Egypt?

THEME 2: The One True God calls Himself, Yahweh -the eternal, self-existent One; who seeks relationship.



Read Ex. 3:13-20

* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 2a. Of all of God's names, why is 'Yahweh' so special to Him?
- 2b. Why would God want us to know Him as Yahweh?
- 2c. Why is it important for you to know Yahweh, the eternal, self-existent, personal God ?

THEME 3: God is supreme, not giving His glory to another. Therefore, all the forces of evil are no match for God.



Read Ex. 5:1-2/ Jer. 16:20-21 and Ex. 6-10

* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 3a. How do these verses reveal God as supreme, with all the forces of evil being no match for Him?
- 3b. Why did God send the plagues on Egypt?
- 3c. How do we know that those in the occult, spirits of the dead, horoscopes, etc. are not of God?
