

LESSON 23 –10 COMMANDMENTS 1

NOTES

THEME 1: God will only accept us if we are absolutely holy. We have no hope of this apart from God.



Read Deut. 4:20 and Ex. 19:4-8

* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 1a. Why did God offer to enter into a covenant with Israel to bless them if they obeyed Him?
- 1b. Why did Israel agree to the covenant while Abel, Noah and Abraham would have refused?
- 1c. What is our only hope to be as holy as God in order to be accepted by Him?

THEME 2: God reveals His holiness and anger at our sin so we would humble ourselves .



Read Ex. 19:12-20

* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 2a. How did God continue His object lesson in order to humble Israel about their sin?
- 2b. Why was Moses allowed to cross the barrier at the base of Mt. Sinai, while everyone else would die?
- 2c. Did God put the barrier at the base of the mountain to merely keep people from coming into His presence?

THEME 3: God has no rivals! Therefore, humble yourself under Him and worship Him alone as supreme.



Read Ex. 20:1-7 and Is. 45:5

* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 3a. How do the first 3 commands reveal God as supreme; not tolerating any rivals?
- 3b. How were Israel to obey these three commands in order to maintain their covenant with God?
- 3c. These laws were for Israel. But if we were Israel, how have we done in worshipping God alone as supreme?
