**THEME 1: Worship God alone as the all-powerful Creator, final ruler and absolute owner of all things.**



Read James 2:10 and Ex. 20:8-12

\* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 1a. How did God demand Israel to obey the 4th and 5th commands if God would accept them?
- 1b. What characteristics of God are revealed in the 4th and 5th commands?
- 1c. If we were Israel, how have you broken the 4th and 5th commands?

**THEME 2: Worship God in faithfulness as the provider and sole source of life.**



Read Ex. 20:13-15 and Mt. 5:21-22, 27-28

\* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 2a. Why would God see murder, adultery and theft as a strike against Him?
- 2b. How does God expand these commands in Mt. 5?
- 2c. If we were Israel, how are you a murderer, adulterer and a thief before God?

**THEME 3: God is righteous, and faithful, and will not give His glory to another.**



Read Ex. 20:16-17 and Lk. 12:2-3

\* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 3a. Why would God command Israel not to lie or covet?
- 3b. How is pride the basis for lying and coveting?
- 3c. If we were Israel, how do you lie and covet?
- 3d. Why can't we be accepted by God based on anything that we have done?
