## NOTES

**THEME 1: A holy God, graciously initiates one means for sinful mankind to be drawn into His embrace.**



Read Ex. 25:8-9/ Ex. 32:1-6 and Lev. 1:3-9

\* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 1a. Why would a holy God desire to dwell with a people who continually defied Him –didn't He know this?
- 1b. How did demonstrate His holiness in how the tabernacle and how Israel was to approach Him?
- 1c. Israel mixed their worship of the golden calf with God. How do we mix our ideas with the truth of the Bible?

**THEME 2: The Deliverer is the only mediator between a holy God and sinful mankind. His blood will be our peace .**



Read Ex. 8:1/ Lev. 9:24 and Lev. 16:2-5, 15

\* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 2a. How did Aaron as a priest reveal that the Deliverer would be our only mediator between God and man?
- 2b. Why do we need the Deliverer to be our 'go-between' with God to make peace with His blood?
- 2c. Why can religious leaders, money or good work not provide us with peace with God?

**THEME 3: God is a loving and merciful owner and ruler over all; and yet He is absolute.**



Read Num. 13:27-28/ Num. 14:2-9 and Gen. 15:16

\* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 3a. How did God demonstrate that He was a loving and merciful ruler over Israel and the nations of Canaan?
- 3b. What was the fate of both Israel and the nations of Canaan for rejecting God?
- 3c. What kind of a ruler does God desire to be in our lives? And why do we need Him?
