all times in the story of Jonah?
1c. What are the ways that we can test the message of modern day prophets?
THEME 2: God is gracious and faithful! He WILL
send His Deliverer to rescue us from our sin,
Satan and lake of fire.
Read Gen. 3:15/ ls. 7:14 and prophecy chart
* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.
2a. How do we see God's grace and faithfulness in all the promises of the coming Deliverer?
2b. Why does God want us to know all these specific prophecies about the coming Deliverer?
2c. Does God get excited at our joy in the coming Deliverer?
THEME 3: The Deliverer will be God Himself -holy
and powerful enough to rescue us from Satan,
sin and the lake of fire.
Read Mal. 3:1 and Is. 40:3
* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.
3a. What is the final, most important piece, that these scriptures reveal about the coming Deliverer?
3b. Why is it important that the Deliverer would be God?
3c. How is God's plan in the Deliverer different than what
all the religions are resting in?
