NOTES

THEME 1: God openly comes as Deliverer/King for all peoples; but He only rescues those who humble themselves.



Read Mt. 2:1-23

* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 1a. How does the account of the wisemen reveal that God openly comes as Deliverer/King for all peoples?
- 1b. How did Herod and the Religious teachers respond to this news?
- 1c. Why must we humble ourselves before Jesus as our Deliverer/King in order for Him to deliver us?

THEME 2: Jesus Christ is fully God and yet He is fully man -giving everything in order to rescue sinful mankind.



Read Lk. 2:40-52 and Phi. 2:6-7

* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 2a. How do these verses reveal that Jesus was fully God and yet fully man?
- 2b. What extent did Jesus go to in order to rescue sinful mankind?
- 2c. As a result, what value does God place on you?

THEME 3: Repent, for Jesus, God the Son, will soon reign as the Deliverer/King.



Read Mt. 3:1-6 and Eph. 2:8-9

* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 3a. How did God have John prepare the way for the Deliverer?
- 3b. Why did John baptise those who repented of their sin?
- 3c. Why doesn't repentance mean that we promise to never sin again?
