2c. How does Satan tempt us in the same way as he did fof Jesus?	
<u>THEME 3</u> : Jesus Christ is Almighty God, the supreme owner and ruler. He alone can set us free.

3c. How is the demon possessed man a picture of each of us in Adam?
