## NOTES

**THEME 1: Jesus is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world as God's final sacrifice.**



Read Jn. 1:29 and Mt. 3:13-17

\* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 1a. What did John mean when he introduced Jesus as the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world?
- 1b. Why did Jesus have to come as a Lamb of God in order to take away the sin of the world?
- 1c. Jesus came to take away the sin of the world, so why do we have to personalize it?

**THEME 2: Jesus is fully God and fully man, able to triumph over his enemy and ours.**



Read Mt. 4:2-10

\* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 2a. How did Jesus reveal who He is in His contest with Satan in the wilderness?
- 2b. What was Satan hoping to accomplish in tempting Jesus? And how successful has he been to date?
- 2c. How does Satan tempt us in the same way as he did for Jesus?

**THEME 3: Jesus Christ is Almighty God, the supreme owner and ruler. He alone can set us free.**



Read Mk. 1:14-26

\* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 3a. How did Jesus reveal that He was God almighty in the opening days of His ministry?
- 3b. How did Jesus demonstrate His authority over the demons as well?
- 3c. How is the demon possessed man a picture of each of us in Adam?
