<u>THEME 2</u> : Jesus is God the Son, the resurrection and the life.
 <u>Read Jn. 11:1-44 and 2 Cor. 4:4</u> * Read the verses a few times and answer the questions. 2a. How does Jesus reveal Himself as the resurrection and the life? 2b. How has the Old Testament taught that there will be
life after death? 2c. What does it mean for us personally that Jesus is the resurrection and the life?
<u>THEME 3</u> : We must have child-like repentance and faith in order to enter into God's kingdom.
 <u>Read Mk. 10:13-23</u> * Read the verses a few times and answer the questions. 3a. What did Jesus mean, 'anyone who doesn't receive the kingdom of God like a child will not enter it?'
3b. How was the rich young man not child-like in how he approached Jesus for salvation and was rejected?
3c. Jesus said it's hard for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God. How does that speak to our rich culture today?
