THEME 1: Jesus is God the Son, providing sinners with their only access to God.

 Read Jn. 10:1-15 and Mt. 7:13-14

* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 1a. What did Jesus mean when He said that He is the door or gate to the sheep fold?
- 1b. How is Jesus a good shepherd?
- 1c. How can we personally know if we are a sheep that belongs to Christ and are secure in Him?

THEME 2: Jesus is God the Son, the resurrection and the life.

 Read Jn. 11:1-44 and 2 Cor. 4:4

* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 2a. How does Jesus reveal Himself as the resurrection and the life?
- 2b. How has the Old Testament taught that there will be life after death?
- 2c. What does it mean for us personally that Jesus is the resurrection and the life?

THEME 3: We must have child-like repentance and faith in order to enter into God's kingdom.

 Read Mk. 10:13-23

* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 3a. What did Jesus mean, 'anyone who doesn't receive the kingdom of God like a child will not enter it?'
- 3b. How was the rich young man not child-like in how he approached Jesus for salvation and was rejected?
- 3c. Jesus said it's hard for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God. How does that speak to our rich culture today?
