NOTES

THEME 1: Jesus is THE Deliverer/King whom some welcome, and others, reject.



Read Mk. 11:1-10/ Mk. 14:1 and Zech. 9:9

* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 1a. How does Jesus triumphant entry reveal those who accept Him versus those who reject Him?
- 1b. How are those who reject Jesus just like their father the devil?
- 1c. How do we know that Jesus hasn't just come to provide us with physical blessings?

THEME 2: Jesus body will be broken and his blood poured out to satisfy God's wrath and fully pay for mankind's sin.



Read Mk. 14:17-25

* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 2a. How does Jesus reveal that His body will be broken and His blood spilt out to pay for mankind's sin?
- 2b. What did Jesus mean that His blood confirmed the covenant between God and His People?
- 2c. Is this new covenant that Jesus began for us today as well, and what is our part in it?

THEME 3: Jesus as God the Son knew, and submitted Himself to the pain, and being the payment for the sin of the world.



Read Mk. 14:32-36

* Read the verses a few times and answer the questions.

- 3a. What words are used to describe Jesus as His death overshadows Him?
- 3b. What did Jesus mean when He asked to 'remove this cup from Him?'
- 3c. How in the world does one respond to the willingness of God the Son to pay for the sin of the world?
